## Behind on rent or utilities?

## The Doña Ana County Emergency Rent & Utilities Assistance Program is here to help.

Doña Ana County received a \$9.3 million grant from the U.S. Department of the Treasury, Emergency Rental Assistance to help residents who were financially impacted by COVID-19 with their rent and renters' utility payments. This grant does not cover mortgage payments nor mortgage owners' utilities.

Money is available for residents of unincorporated areas and those within the municipalities of the cities of Las Cruces, Sunland Park and Anthony, the Village of Hatch and the Town of Mesilla.




Not Eligible: Household income must be verified at or below 80% AMI.

Are you late or expect to be late on your payments?






Has anyone in the household experienced any of these financial impacts related to COVID-19?
